Dear Candidates, Municipalities of Jefferson County,
and other interested parties:

On Tuesday, September 22, 2015, nominations were accepted to fill the seats of the Citizens Supervisory Commission for the Municipal Employee Representative and County Employee Representative. For the County Employee Representative, one nomination was received and as a result, no election will be necessary; however, we did not receive any nominations for a Municipal Employee Representative.

Due to the aforementioned circumstances, nominations are hereby reopened and will be accepted on Friday, October 16, 2015, in the Jefferson County Probate Court, First Floor, Room 140 (Election Office), Jefferson County Courthouse, 716 Richard Arrington Blvd., Birmingham, Alabama 35203. If needed, the election will be held on Tuesday, October 27, 2015.

Pursuant to the Enabling Act of the Personnel Board, a commission member may succeed himself for one year only; however, no employee of any municipal police or fire department and no employee of any other municipal department shall succeed an employee of the same municipal department as a member of the commission. In addition, no single municipality shall have employee representation upon the commission for more than three successive terms. Therefore, nominees from the Tarrant Police Department cannot be accepted.
